2010 North Urban Human Services Alliance Human Service Awards Criteria

Outstanding Organization/Program

This award will be given to an established agency or program that provides outstanding services to low-income people within North King County including the cities of Lake Forest Park, Shoreline, Kenmore, Bothell and Woodinville, or who's business efforts have included support toward human services within their community. The nominated agency or program will have:

- The ability to creatively leverage resources to maximize the benefits or support;
- Innovative approaches to meeting human service needs;
- Excellence in organizational staff training and development; or
- Demonstrates a commitment to accessibility and cultural diversity; or
- Continued evaluation and attention to program results; and
- Effective and collaborative efforts to advocate for clients and services.

The nominated business will have:

- The ability to creatively leverage resources to maximize supporting Human Services in their community;
- Innovative approaches to supporting human services or devoting resources (financial or otherwise) toward the advancement of human services work;
- Promotes employee/corporate involvement within their community;
- Creates a better community and improves the quality of life for the citizens of North King County; and
- Effective and collaborative efforts to advocate human services.

Note: One organization, nonprofit, school, service club, business or faith-based award will be given annually.

Individual Advocating for Human Services

This award will be presented to an individual who:

- Is instrumental in creating positive change;
- Identifies and meets unmet needs in the community;
- Supports human services by devoting resources (financial or otherwise) to the development, continuation or advancement of human services work;
- Creates a better community and improves the quality of life for the citizens of North King County; and
- Fosters public awareness to the importance of human services.

The selection process will further take into consideration how the individual, organization or business efforts help to advance NUHSA's four goals:

- Provide a strong voice and leadership role in local and regional human service decisions.
- Identify and communicate emerging community human service needs and issues.
- Support cooperation, coordination and collaboration among providers, funders and the community to enhance resources and the ability to respond to need in the community.
- Advocate for a continuum of care that increases access to services.
