VISION: *A world-class transportation network that allows all people to move freely around North King County*

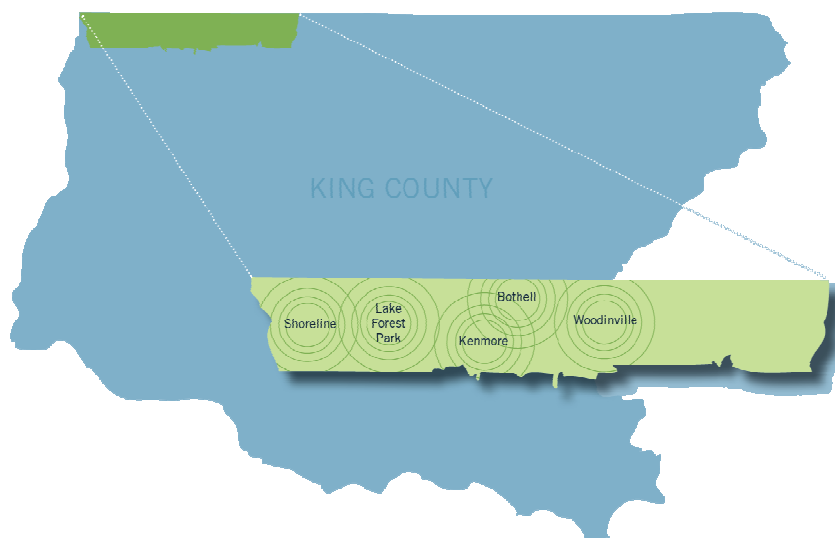
GOALS: We support the region's coordinated transportation goals:
